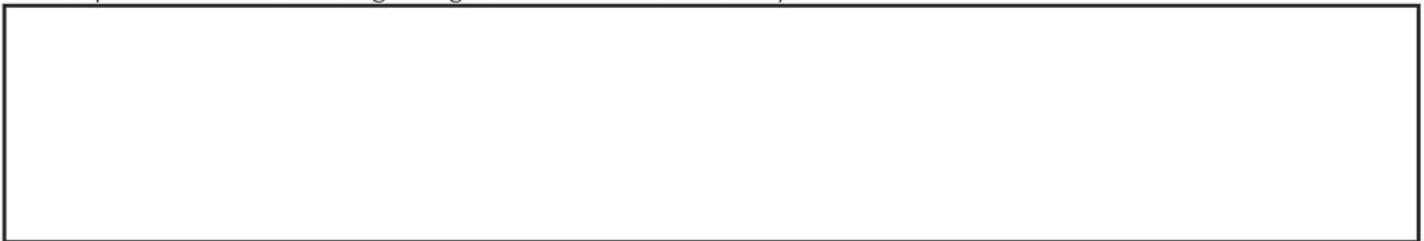

FBI Employees Reviewing Jeffrey Epstein Files Told to Limit Redactions

Officials worry sensitive information will be exposed in Trump administration's push to release material

WASHINGTON—Hundreds of FBI employees have been working long shifts examining documents from the bureau's investigation into disgraced financier Jeffrey Epstein, making only limited redactions that some officials worry will expose sensitive information about sex-abuse victims and witnesses, people familiar with the matter said.

Attorney General Pam Bondi ordered the review after a first batch of Epstein files she released in February fell short of expectations. She had promoted the earlier

release for days but the material contained few new revelations, drawing criticism from right-wing influencers.

Bondi promised there was more to come, saying a source in the Federal Bureau of Investigation's New York field office had told her the bureau withheld thousands of pages of Epstein-related documents. FBI Director Kash Patel promised "no stone left unturned."

"We've received a truckload of documents, of evidence, and Kash is going to give me a deadline on when he can go through that to protect, of course, the victims of sex trafficking who are wrapped into this," Bondi said on Fox News last week.

Some on the right have suggested the government concealed information about a list of men who abused some of Epstein's victims, which they believe would include powerful Democrats. No evidence has surfaced that such a list exists. Women who were trafficked by Epstein have named more than 20 men as alleged participants in sexual exploitation or abuse, according to a lawyer representing many of those women.

Under pressure from Patel, agents and other FBI employees in New York and at headquarters in Washington have been pulled from other duties to work 12-hour shifts to pore over the material, people familiar with the effort said. They have been instructed to redact only a list of victim names and their personally identifiable information, like phone numbers and social-media handles, the people said. A victim's city and state must be disclosed, under the terms of the review.

Reviewers were told not to blacken entire chunks of text and that no other third-party names will be protected, the people said, meaning details of witnesses, victims' relatives and people close to them could become public. If reviewers find nude photos of victims, they can redact the entire body, but if the victim is clothed, they are instructed to only black out the victim's face.

Many of the people doing the redactions have no experience with such sensitive work, the people said. Some employees involved in the review worry victims will be identifiable through other details, and that sensitive information will be compromised, the people said. They worry the documents will inadvertently expose the names of people who weren't identified among the listed victims.

Current and former officials said the process is a break from normal procedures designed to safeguard sensitive witness and victim information.

The Justice Department referred questions to the FBI. An FBI spokesman said Patel and Deputy Director Dan Bongino, at Bondi's direction, "have prioritized transparency with the Epstein files. All appropriate administrative and legal requirements are being adhered to."

A Wall Street Journal investigation found that Epstein's sexual exploitation and abuse didn't end with his 2008 conviction in Florida state court—as many of his famous associates later said they believed—but continued until his second arrest by federal authorities in 2019. He lured dozens of women by promising to use his connections to powerful people to get them jobs or other opportunities. He then groomed most of the women for his personal sexual exploitation. He killed himself in prison in 2019, according to the New York City medical examiner, while awaiting trial on charges of sex trafficking that could have kept him imprisoned for the rest of his life.

Much of the information under FBI review was already examined as part of the federal prosecution of British socialite Ghislaine Maxwell, who was convicted of a decade-long scheme to help Epstein. Many of the most relevant details were used at her 2022 trial. She was sentenced to 20 years in prison.

After conservatives labeled Bondi's first document release a flop, the FBI's New York office, which investigated Epstein, has borne the brunt of the fallout. The top agent in the office, James Dennehy, was forced out, which came as Patel has sought to upend the bureau and overhaul its structure.

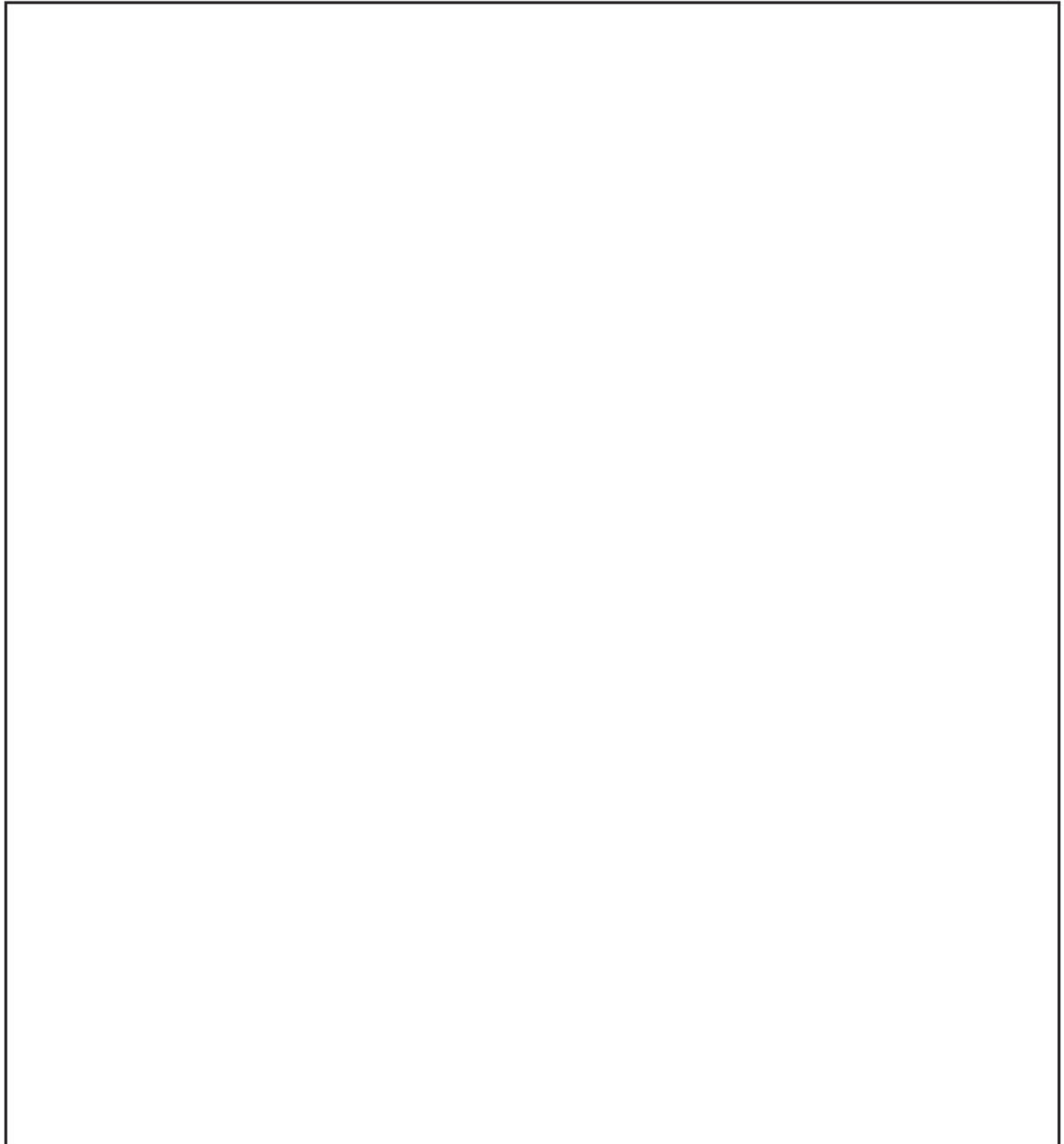

Attached please find an initial estimate of processing time required for redacting digital media in the Epstein case. IMD, NY, CID, OTD, and WFO processing equities and contributions are included.

Based on total items of extracted/reconstituted digital items, current estimated processing time for all video, audio, and photograph redaction is **1,561,351 labor hours**. (Note: If all videos also contain audio, estimate processing time could double. Video frames are redacted separately than audio). Also, as of 3/21/2025, only 14% of 1B media had processed for reconstitution due to file size and processing speed. Therefore, we expect this number to increase.

PURPOSE: In response of the Attorney General's letter dated 02/27/2025, the Federal Bureau of Investigation is providing redacted copies of documents received in the JEFFREY EPSTEIN and GHISLAINE MAXWELL's investigation related to child sex trafficking.

FOR YOUR INFORMATION

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: Pursuant to your request, the Federal Bureau of Investigation is providing your office copies of 240 serials (851 pages) of documents obtained by the FBI in its investigation of JEFFREY EPSTEIN and GHISLAINE MAXWELL for child sex trafficking (Attachment A).

DISCUSSION: This production comprises material from FBI file 50D-NY-3027571 and reflects the first tranche of documents prepared for your review with translucent (see-thru) redactions. The FBI is also providing a fully redacted version as well. The FBI anticipates the second tranche of documents will be ready for digital transmission to the Department on March 25, 2025, with digital transmission continuing weekly.

This material has been processed in a manner whereby limited redactions were applied by analogy to the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552, as amended (FOIA). Consistent with routine FBI FOIA processing of investigative files for public dissemination under FOIA, redactions for Exemption 1 (classified national security), Exemption 3 (other federal statutes that mandate withholding), and Exemption 7D (confidential source identities and information provided) were applied. However, other FOIA Exemptions were not applied in their entirety or were applied in a more limited fashion to maximize transparency. The information redacted can be readily identified by the processing code associated with the information in the attached Coding Chart (Attachments B and C).

Additionally, no redactions were applied to information that would otherwise be protected from public disclosure by the Privacy Act of 1974, 5 U.S.C. 552a, as amended. Examples of

information that is not redacted includes the names of third parties, state and local law enforcement officers and witnesses, and information that may be subject to the attorney client or other privileges held by the Executive Branch. Accordingly, this version is not suitable for public dissemination. The FBI requests the Department coordinate with the FBI in advance of any public disclosure.
